INSTALLATION

INSTALL WITH SPRAY ADHESIVES & STAPLES - NO - NAILS OR SCREWS

- 1. Cut and dry-fit the bead to length.
- 2. Spray the bead and then the drywall with Trim-Tex 847 Spray Adhesive. Immediately apply to the drywall.
- Once in position, press the legs into place using the free installation tool or handle of your taping knife.
- Staple both legs every 6"-8" with ½" long divergent staples.
- Finish with drywall compound. To boost the performance and strength of your drywall compound, use Trim-Tex's high performance MUD-MAX drywall compound additive.
- 6. Remove tear-off strip to leave a clean finished edge.
- 7. Fill caulk channel after the bead has been installed & finished.
