





- Resists dents, paint chipping, shrinkage and common cracking problems

Cut Strait-Flex® Original Tape to desired length. Fold in half at center crease with print together. For inside corner, the print faces out. For outside corners, the print faces the wall. To ensure the Strait-Flex Original Tape lays flat on the wall, fold less than angle for inside corners; and for outside corners more than the angle. Using a 5" or 6" taping knife, apply a liberal coat of all-purpose joint compound to corner. Press Strait-Flex Original Tape into wet compound. Adjust if necessary to create a straight line. Wipe down with knife with additional pressure to the outer edge of Strait-Flex Original Tape. Immediately apply light skim coat of joint compound and let dry. Apply final coat, let dry and sand

When applied to a sound structure using recommended application instructions, this product is backed by Strait-Flex Limited Warranty against edge cracks or flange deformations. Strait-Flex products withstand reasonable forces that cause edge cracking and flange deformation. Warranty does not apply to impacts. Refer to Strait-Flex Limited Warranty for complete warranty details.
